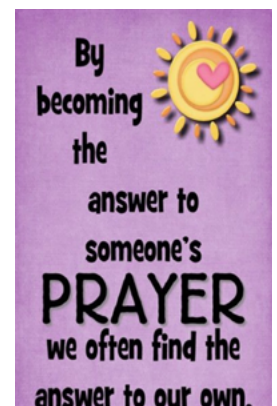

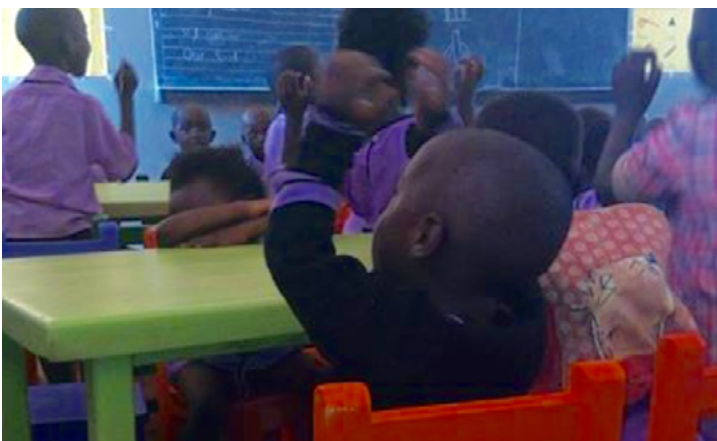
Miss Zura is such a delight to have at our school. Her smile is infectious. She has done an excellent job this first term as well.
